



FURGO DOG RUN VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

You must sign this Release, Waiver and Confirmation stating that your dog's vaccinations from a licensed veterinarian are CURRENT. We recommend that you contact your veterinarian regarding other vaccinations that may suit your dog's needs.

REQUIRED VACCINATIONS

Rabies - given annually, but sometimes can be a 3 year. DHLPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza) - all given annually, sometimes referred to as the Combo Vaccination, especially when it includes Parvo. Parvo - given annually, many times this is included in the DHLPP and indicated as DHLPP. Bordetella - given either every six months or annually. Sometimes referred to as: Kennel Cough OR Tracheobronchitis.

All dogs must be leashed (no retractable leashes) and licensed. Ventures Endurance Events LLC d/b/a Fargo Marathon ("Organizer") reserves the right to deny any dog or human entrance to the Furgo Dog Run event for any reason they may see fit. Participants are expected to practice responsible pet ownership. You (the owner) are liable in the event of an incident. Please come prepared to clean up after your dog.

RELEASE, WAIVER AND CONFIRMATION

1. You represent that you are the legal owner of the dog(s) named below and you assume all risks, dangers and responsibility for injuries to the named dog(s). You, understand and agree that you are solely responsible for any harm to your dog(s) while your dog(s) is/are attending and/or participating in the Dog Run.
2. You represent that your dog(s) is/are in good health, is/are current on all required vaccinations and have not harmed, shown aggressions, or exhibited any threatening behavior towards any person or other dog.
3. You further understand and agree that neither Organizer nor any of its employees, staff or volunteers, will be liable for any illness, injury, death and/or escape of your dog(s) provided that reasonable care and precautions are followed and you hereby release all of them of any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from or as a result of your or your dog(s) presence or participation in the Dog Walk.
4. You confirm your dog(s) do not have any condition that could potentially jeopardize the health of other dogs or people and has not had any potentially communicable condition within 30 days prior to service or care.
5. Organizer reserves the right to remove any dog from the Dog Walk who does not meet the health, temperament or other Dog Walk standards. The determination shall be made at the sole discretion of Organizer.
6. COVID-19 Waiver.

(a) The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life threatening illness and even death. Organizer cannot prevent you from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 at the Dog Walk. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to attend the Dog Walk you may be exposed to or increase the risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

(b) ASSUMPTION OF RISK: You have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19 and have chosen to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 in order to be at and participate in the Dog Walk. The opportunity is of such a value to you that you accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to attend the Dog Walk in person and participate as contemplated hereunder.

(c) WAIVER OF LAWSUIT/LIABILITY: By having the opportunity for the access and participate in the Dog Walk as contemplated hereunder, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, you forever release and waive any right to bring suit against Organizer and its officers, directors, shareholders, managers, officials, trustees, agents, employees, or other representatives and affiliated or related parties in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to access to or presence at the event hereunder. You understand that this waiver means giving up the right to bring any claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claim to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen.
